At its annual meeting on March 4, 2018 grants to the following Roanoke District UMC Churches and community partners totaling \$61,000 were approved for distribution from the Board of Mission and Church Extension :

- Belview UMC for roof replacement and related repairs (\$5,000)
- Botetourt Resource Center for assistance for needy families (\$1,000)
- Community Christmas Store for assistance to families in need (\$1,000)
- Community Outreach Program for children literacy program (\$10,000)
- Community Outreach Program for youth program (\$10,000)
- Family Promise of Greater Roanoke for program to return homeless to independent living (\$3,000)
- Food Pantry of Salem and Roanoke County for serving families in need (\$1,200)
- Local Office on Aging for Meals on Wheels program (\$4,000)
- Mays Memorial UMC for school backpack program (\$2,000)
- Parrish Chapel UMC for community food pantry program (\$1,500)
- Presbyterian Community Center for Emergence food/finance assistance (\$1,000)
- Roanoke Area Ministries for emergency crisis assistance program (\$3,000)
- TAP Total Action Against Poverty for permanent supportive housing program (\$5,000)
- Windsor Hills UMC for Persons with disabilities events (\$600)
- Discretionary Fund for emergencies needs as determined by the DS (\$12,700)
