Our Facilities and Programs

- Alta Mons offers 10 unique retreat facilities plus 18 rustic cabins and 44 campsites
- Summer Camp serves more than 200 campers per year from Kindergarten through 12th grade
- Winter Camp is a special offering which focuses on the joy of Christmas
- Challenge Courses offer unique team building activities

Our Guests

- Alta Mons hosted more than 10,000 guests in 2019!
- Alta Mons hosts guests of all ages, whether at summer camp or other events
- Alta Mons hosted 150 retreat groups in 2019
- Guests use our facilities for many events, like family reunions, corporate retreats, weddings, and more

- 22% of donations contribute to summer camp scholarships
- Roanoke District UMC Apportionments funded 26% of our budget in 2019

Alta Mons has served the New River Valley and beyond since the 1890s. First as Crockett Springs Bottling Co., then developed as a resort surrounding the famous "healing waters". In 1957, the property was purchased by the Roanoke District UMC for use as a summer camp, which leads us to today – serving the surrounding community with educational opportunities, retreat facilities, environmental initiatives, and a home away from home for many of our supporters.
