

Nomination and Leadership Development Reporting

As you continue preparations for your charge conference we ask that your Nominations & Leadership Development team not only fill the traditional committees but also identify and (record in EVC) persons who can serve in these often overlooked leadership areas:

District Steward: each church/charge should elect a District Steward. This person will represent the church at the annual meeting of District Stewards to review District budget recommendations and send apportionments to District churches. They are the only vote from the church in this matter (clergy have voice but no vote)

District Board of Mission: each church/charge should elect a District Board of Missions representative who along with their clergy will represent the church at the annual meeting of the District Board of Mission and Church Extension to review and vote on grant recommendations and other related matters.

Camp Representative: each church/charge is encouraged to elect/appoint a representative (clergy or lay) to represent the church and attend the annual meeting of Alta Mons. This person will help connect the church to the camp by sharing events and information with the congregation.

Higher Education and Campus Ministry: each church/charge is encouraged to elect/appoint a person (clergy or lay) to help strengthen the connection between our churches and local campus ministry and those throughout the conference.

Hermitage Representative: each church/charge is encouraged to elect/appoint a person (clergy or lay) to help connect the church with Pinnacle Living's Hermitage Roanoke and their activities, services, and ministry.

Scouting & Civic Youth Service Ministry: if your church is involved in scouting please report a contact person in EVC so we can connect them with our district and conference coordinators and relay necessary information to them.

Disaster Coordinator: the VAUMC Disaster Response Plan recommends each church designate a person(s) to oversee local church disasters and work with district and conference coordinators in the event of need.
